LGMS to disguise as PC support engineers to gain full physical access to workstations used by bank staff.

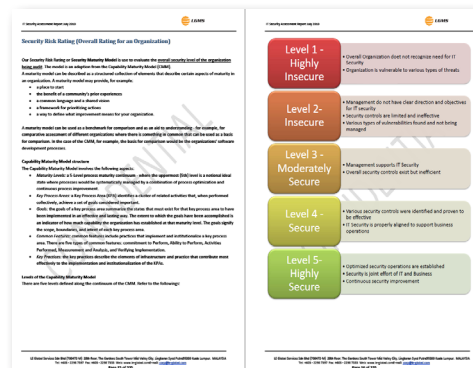
Example 3.
